The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.74 dated 23.04.2009, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise, which as per counsel has been entered into between the parties.

During the course of arguments it has gone uncontroverted that respondent No.3 i.e. Parkash Kaur, who had suffered injuries in the alleged occurrence has since been expired.

Even learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jaspal Singh, would apprise the court that trial in the case is at the

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final stage in as much as all the prosecution witnesses as cited have been examined.

In the light of above position, this Court would not be inclined to entertain the present petition for quashing of the above said FIR.

Petition is accordingly, dismissed.
