Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in compliance of directions issued by this Court on 27.3.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have been released on interim bail. Learned counsel further contends that as it is a case of version and cross-version, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioners but submits that weapons have not been recovered so far.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and the matter has also been compromised between the parties because of the version and cross-version case, interim order dated 27.3.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
