This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station A. Division, District Amritsar City, vide FIR No.33 dated 30.01.2014.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that offence under section 406 IPC has also been added in the FIR.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to move a fresh petition before the court of Sessions.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

Arrest of the petitioner shall, however, remain stayed for a period of ten days.
