Manu Sharma and Pardeep Mehta wife and husband have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on March 22, 2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved an application (Annexure P-5) before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to seek protection but no action has been taken by the Police.

In this view of the matter, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to look into the application (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of their matrimonial alliance.
