Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 298 dated 12.11.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in fact the matter has been compromised and a compromise deed dated 28.4.2015/1.5.2015 (Annexure A-1) has been reduced into writing between the petitioner and the complainant. The compromise deed goes to the extent that the

complainant has no objection if the FIR and the subsequent proceedings are quashed.

Mr. Sumeet Singh Brar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and he endorses the compromise (Annexure A-1).

In view of the fact that the matter has been resolved between the parties by effecting a compromise to this effect, no useful purpose will be served to detain the petitioner in custody for longer period. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
