Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the SHO/Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail in cross version registered under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148, 149 in FIR No.115 dated 19.11.2014 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC later on added 326 IPC at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated January 30, 2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated January 30, 2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.
