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MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.72 dated 27.2.2015 under Sections 406/498A IPC registered at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 27.3.2015 the petitioner has joined the investigation. Apart from that the matter has been settled inter se between the parties and the petitioner under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed and the matter is now fixed for 7.11.2015.

In view of the above, the interim directions dated 27.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
