The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.57 dated 04.10.2014 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (in short, "I.P.C.") and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Gardhiwala, District Hoshiarpur.

2. The submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioner and learned counsel representing the State of Punjab have been considered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted and it was conceded by learned counsel for the State of Punjab that Section 307 I.P.C. has since been deleted from the case. Status report to the said effect has been filed by learned counsel for the State by way of affidavit of Karanveer Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

4. The petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2015. Trial of the case is still likely to take some time and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody. He is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/Trial Court, Hoshiarpur.
