MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.14 dated 31.12.2014 under Section 380 IPC registered at Police Station NRI, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that travel documents of the complainant are not with the petitioner and are with his parents who are residing in Canada.

Noticing the aforesaid, interim protection was granted to the petitioner on 27.3.2015 subject to his complying with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., pursuant to which he has joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel for the State.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 27.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
