The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.7 dated 03.01.2015, registered under Sections 420, 384, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot.

Heard.

A complaint was made by the President of the Crushers Union at Madhopur containing the allegations that the petitioner along with 15 – 20 persons carrying hockey sticks and baseball bats were present in their vehicles and were extracting Rs.100/- from truck drivers who were carrying Bajri and were issuing paper slips. The allegations are that the chits were recovered by the police and the petitioner is the king-pin.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious. The petitioner along with his co-accused are accused of extorting money and violating the provisions of Mines and Minerals Act, causing loss to the Government. Custodial investigation is necessary to unearth the nexus. No case for exercising the discretion in favour of the petitioners is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
