It is submitted by State counsel that the report of Neurologist relating to the present condition of health of the petitioner is not received. However, the petitioner is in custody since 31.08.2014 and was booked for having been allegedly found in possession of 72 kgs of poppy husk.

Charges have yet not been drawn up and the trial is, therefore, likely to take long time to conclude.

State counsel, on instructions from the police official present in Court today in connection with the case, submits that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
