RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

Petitioners pray that respondents No.1 to 3 be directed to protect their life and liberty from being invaded by respondents No.4 and 5.

The background in which the aforesaid prayer has been made is that earlier petitioners were serving respondents No.4 and 5 against a very meager and marginal salary. They left the employment and their dues were not paid by the private respondents on repeated demands, rather on 3.3.2015, they were summoned under the pretext of paying their dues by the private respondents and were brutally beaten there. Petitioners received injuries. Petitioner No.2 was even operated also.

Now the grievance of the petitioners is that the private respondents are again compelling them to join the employment. Precisely, in the aforesaid context, initial complaint was made by the petitioners to respondent No.3 and on seeing pathetic attitude of the police, they even moved representation before respondent No.2. However, the said representation also yielded no result and now they have approached this Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Amritpal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order, which this court proposes to pass at this stage, it is not necessary to issue notice to respondents No.4 and 5. Respondent No.2 may look into the grievance of the petitioners and take all remedial steps as are permissible under law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
