This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.954 dated 07.11.2006 under Sections 398 and 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Gurgaon..

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Naresh Kumar submits that out of 08 witnesses cited by the prosecution 06 have already been examined.

It appears that trial is nearing its culmination. There is, thus, no ground to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Dismissed. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to file afresh in case the trial does not conclude within a period of three months.
