Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, fairly states that since the impugned order terminating the services of the petitioners was stayed by this Court and in compliance thereof, petitioners continued in service, now they have attained the age of superannuation and retired from service, rendering the present writ petition as infructuous. She further submits that let instant writ petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty may be granted to the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for any service benefit for which they are found entitled in law.

In view of the above-said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.
