By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92, dated 29.11.2014, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that order of the trial Court was not conveyed to the petitioner. The petitioner is ready and willing to repay the amount.

Perusal of the record would reveal this is the second petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. The petitioner undertook to repay Rs. 60,000/- before the trial Court which was not deposited.

Subsequently, the petitioner had filed CRM-M No. 4883 of 2015

before this Court which was dismissed, vide order dated 13.02.2015.

In earlier petition also i.e. CRM-M No. 4883 of 2015, no averment with regard to no communication of the order of the learned trial Court was raised by the petitioner. The FIR in the instant case was registered on 29.11.2014. The petitioner is repeatedly avoiding the process of the Court, instead of surrendering herself before the process of the Court.

In the circumstances, no case for bail is made out.
