AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.659 dated 31.12.2014 registered under Sections 498-A, 323 and Section 34 IPC at Police Station Mohindergarh, Haryana.

Today the parties are present and it has been agreed that the respondent No.2 shall accompany the petitioner from the Court premises.

On 03.08.2015 the following order was passed:-

"The parties have settled the dispute before the

Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The settlement is on record. Since it has been signed by both the parties they are bound by it. One matter inter se between the parties i.e proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C is pending before the Court of competent jurisdiction for tomorrow i.e 4.8.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter may be adjourned to enable the parties to effectively take steps pursuant to the settlement.

Adjourned to 17.8.2015. “

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
