RAJAN GUPTA J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No. 532 dated 28.08.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 307 IPC and sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 29.08.2014. According to him, trial is in progress and three prosecution witnesses have already been examined. Thus, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard.

Keeping in view the aforesaid contentions and period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is

ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial
Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Fatehabad.
