Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.21 dated 23.02.2013, under Sections 406/498-A IPC registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Kamaljit Kaur alleging that the petitioner along with his family members had maltreated the complainant on account of bringing insufficient dowry.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised and the parties have decided to part company by obtaining divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

In view of said circumstances and following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
