Learned State counsel has filed the status report with respect to the other cases against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for co-accused Kuldeep Singh could not be able to show any judicial precedent that co-accused has locus standi to oppose the bail application. So, co-accused Kuldeep Singh cannot be allowed to oppose this bail application.

After addressing some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with a direction to learned trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the application of the petitioner for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.

If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today, the trial Court will decide his application for grant of regular bail within three days after the expiry of the police remand, if any.
