Learned State counsel has made a statement on behalf of the official respondents that they shall not in any manner interfere in the smooth running of the licenced business activities of the petitioner and shall act within the framework of law and shall not use any coercive means in either putting to hold their business activities or detaining them unnecessarily except after adopting the due procedure of law.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the official respondents are bound by their statements and the

petitioner will reserve their right to move the Court in case official respondents misuse their powers.
