SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 864 dated 13.12.2014 under Sections 20,61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that a plastic bag containing 10 kg of Ganja was recovered from her possession and the bag containing 10 kg Ganja was recovered from the co-accused. He further submits that the contraband recovered from the present petitioner does not fall under the commercial quantity.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the co-accused namely Ram Pal has already been granted bail by learned trial Court. Submitting that the petitioner is in custody since 13.12.2014 learned counsel prayed that she be enlarged on regular bail.

The prayer was opposed by learned State counsel.

The petitioner is a lady. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in the near future, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is released on bail subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kurukshetra.
