Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Kulbir Singh and Amrik Singh sons of Gurdial Singh, Manjit Singh and Randhir Kumar sons of Balak Ram, residents of Village Lohsimbli, Tehsil Rajpura, District Patiala, in case FIR No.98 dated 7.11.2014, under Sections 302, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, later on Section 302 IPC was substituted by Section 304 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Baljit Singh submits that pursuant to the order dated April 01, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid assertion, interim order dated April 01, 2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the

petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and shall abide the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of.

It is made clear that nothing observed herein shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the learned trial court shall consider the case on the basis of evidence and material as produced before it.
