HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners illegally at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 as well as directing the respondents No. 2 and 3 to restrain respondents No. 4 to 6 from interfering in the married life of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners being major have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No.4 to 6 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, i.e. respondent No.2

Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter but without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 to take appropriate action, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 6.
