PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising out of FIR No.164 dated 24.09.2014 under Sections 420/380/406/408/120-B/34 IPC registered at Police Station City Mukatsar Sahib, District Mukatsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that charge has been framed and the petitioners have been behind bars since 21.10.2014. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

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Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mukatsar Sahib.
