Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to carry fair and impartial investigation in the case bearing FIR No.145 dated 8.10.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC (Sections 307/326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Respondents No.1 to 4 have filed their reply by way of affidavit of Suba Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran. Perusal of the reply shows that the investigation in the case is complete. Para 5 of the reply reads as

under :-

“5. That after completion of investigation and arrest of all accused except Ajmer Singh who found innocent during enquiry conducted by Dy.S.P. Goindwal Sahib, Challan report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in version and cross version cases were presented before the Court of Smt. Amandeep Kaur, SDJM Khadoor Sahib on 11.5.2015 and were committed to the Court of Sessions for 25.5.2015.”

In view of the reply submitted by respondents No.1 to 4, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
