Petitioners have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on 16.02.2014 against the wishes of their parents and relatives and have a female child also from the wedlock. It is stated that now brother of petitioner No. 2 has started threatening them. Hence, this petition.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the police.

In this view of the matter, Senior Superintendent of Police,

Mohali, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of their matrimonial alliance.
