Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.119 dated 29.08.2013, under Sections 452/323/324/148/149/506 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Gurdaspur on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Deepak Kumar alleging that the petitioners had constituted an unlawful assembly and assaulted the complainant and his family members.

Parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the

criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector 22 Chandigarh within a period of one month.
