MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 83 dated 18.11.2014 registered under Sections 3(1)(4)/3 (1) (5) of SC & ST Act at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is a 70 years old man and allegations are based on account of a dispute regarding possession.

Noticing the aforesaid facts this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner vide its order dated 31.3.2015.

The petitioner has since joined investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim

directions dated 31.3.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
