The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.6 dated 30.7.2014 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station NRI, District Ludhiana.

On instructions from ASI Bikkar Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner in compliance of the order dated 6.4.2015 has joined the investigation. Her custodial interrogation is not necessary as nothing remains to be recovered from her.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 6.4.2015 vide which the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is made absolute. She shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
