Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 47 dated 14.04.2014, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 394, 323, 427, 380, 452, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is a second anticipatory bail application. Earlier was dismissed on merit by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.08.2014 (Annexure P/9). Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the competent Court and move regular bail application

and prays that his regular bail application be decided expeditiously.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner may surrender/appear before the Court. In the event of his doing so, his regular bail application be decided in accordance with law within a week.
