The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 81 dated 17.07.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot under Sections 394/34/413 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the co-accused Sukhvir Singh @ Sukha had been allowed bail and it was Parminder Singh who had caused the injury.

The allegations against Parminder Singh and Davinder Singh @ Lakha were that they came on motor cycle and Parminder inflicted blow upon the complainant and snatched the bag containing cash and gold ornaments. Some recovery has also been effected from the petitioner. Parminder Singh is stated to be the main accused. The petitioner is in custody for the last 8 months.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
