**MAHESH GROVER, J.**

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 766 dated 14.11.2014 registered under Sections 418, 420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Section 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Sections 3, 4, 4A/3/67 of Public Gambling Act, 1867 at Police Station Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the petitioner was neither named in the FIR nor any particular role has been attributed to him. On 13.1.2015 this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner subject to compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and pursuant thereto the petitioner has finally submitted himself to the investigating officer on 8.4.2015 which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Suresh Kumar.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts, instant petition is allowed. Interim directions dated 13.1.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
