Petitioner and the complainant were present in the Court on 18.03.2015 and had made statements that the matter has been amicably settled. Complainant and the petitioner have parted company by filing a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he will join investigation as and when required and that he would comply with the terms and conditions of the settlement.

In case of non-compliance of any of the conditions, it will be open to the complainant or the prosecution agency to approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
