This is a third petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case arising from FIR No.322 dated 11.10.2011, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, under Sections 307/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Sh. Opinderjit Singh Ghuman, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala which is taken on record.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There were 39 cases pending against the petitioner as mentioned in order dated 06.08.2013 passed in CRM-M-20659-2013. As per the affidavit of Mr. Ghuman filed today in Court, number of cases pending against the petitioner has swelled and reached upto 47. Perusal of affidavit reveals that out of 47 cases, the petitioner has been acquitted in 26 cases, convicted in 2 cases and is facing trial in remaining cases. Learned State counsel has also brought into notice of this Court that if the petitioner is granted bail, no one will appear as witness against him. Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground for regular bail to the petitioner is made out.
