This petition has been filed by petitioner Surmu under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter called Cr.P.C) for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 162 dated 17.07.2014, under Sections 411, 414, 389A, 489B, 489C of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter called IPC), Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act , Section 14 Foreigners Act,1946 and Section 3/34/20 of Indian Passport Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

As per the prosecution allegations, the present case was got registered on the basis of general type of allegations against the petitioner and various other persons

on the basis of some secret information indulging in criminal activities.

The petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 06.04.2015. As per the information given by learned State counsel, on the basis of instructions, received from the police official, came present from the concerned police station that petitioner has already joined the investigation. He has been sufficiently interrogated. No incriminating article has been recovered from his possession and he is no longer required for any interrogation/ custodial interrogation.

Thus, the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 06.04.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the following conditions:

1. that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
 2. that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
 3. that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
- Petition stands disposed of.
