Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.147 dated 26.6.2014 under Sections 326/325/324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) and affidavits dated 21.3.2015 (Annexures P-3 and P4).

This Court vide order dated 1.4.2015 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the trial Court was directed to submit its report about the genuineness of the compromise as per the statements so recorded. Accordingly, the parties have

appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala and have got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded by the parties, learned Magistrate has submitted his report dated 10.4.2015 to the effect that the compromise entered between the parties is genuine and the same has been effected between the parties out of their free will and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 (P&H) and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and others**, (2012)10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and FIR No.147 dated 26.6.2014 under Sections 326/325/324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) is quashed on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) and affidavits dated 21.3.2015 (Annexures P-3 and P4).
