The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.66 dated 25.08.2014 under Sections 363, 366, 376 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

2. Precisely, the accusation against the petitioner is that he enticed away daughter of complainant Darshan Singh son of Chhota Singh for either marrying her himself or with some other person. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since the date of his arrest.

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3. Learned State counsel submits that prosecutrix and other public witnesses have already been examined.

4. Heard the submissions made by Ms. Rajwinder Kaur, learned counsel representing the petitioner and Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, learned Deputy Advocate General representing the State of Punjab.

5. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances and without going into merits and for the fact that the trial is still likely to take some time whereas there is no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody, he is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/Trial Court, Barnala.
