MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 27 dated 1.5.2014 registered under Section 306 IPC read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station, GRP, Sonipat.

According to the FIR the husband of the petitioner committed suicide upon finding the petitioner in objectionable position and in a state of undress with two persons with whom she was having illicit relations. The deceased committed suicide on discovering the petitioner in this state.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that she is in custody for last 11 months and the trial is likely to take some time. It is also stated that the complainant who is brother of the deceased is not supporting the case any more.

Be that as it may be and without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the period of incarceration of the petitioner, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.
