HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and family members of petitioner No.2 at the hands of respondents No.6 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in support of age of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2, Birth Certificate(Annexure P-1) and Driving Licence (Annexure P-2) have been placed on record respectively. A copy of the *Adhaar Card* issued in the name of petitioner No.1, namely, Reena Yadav, has also been produced in the Court today, wherein, her date of birth is shown in the year 1994. Learned counsel further submits that in view of the aforesaid documents, the petitioners being major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No. 6 to 11 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal

means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, District-Gurgaon, (Haryana) as well as to the Superintendent of Police, District-Hisar, (Haryana) i.e. respondents No.2 and 3 respectively.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter but without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to take appropriate action, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.6 to 11.
