This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 75 dated 9.9.2014 under Sections 457, 380 I.P.C., registered at Police Station, Maloud, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 1.4.2015:-

“Counsel would submit that the allegation is with regard to theft of buffalo. Recovery has already been effected from co-accused and who has been granted the benefit of bail.

Notice of motion, returnable for 6.7.2015.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from H.C. Surjit Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Counsel would further submit that upon completion of investigation even

the challan has been presented. Even the observations contained in the notice of motion order have not been rebutted.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed. Order dated 1.4.2015, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
