Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in cross version case dated 11.11.2014 under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of the IPC (Sections 325 and 326 of the IPC added later on) in case FIR No. 172 dated 11.11.2014, registered under Sections 324/323/34 IPC, Police Station Moga Sadar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 01.04.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC-Santok Singh Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 01.04.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
