FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Statements of the parties have been recorded which are supported by their sworn affidavits and this Court is satisfied that the compromise between the parties which has already been reduced into writing by way of compromise deed (Annexure P2) and statements before this Court are voluntary one and are without any influence or pressure.

Keeping in view the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute between the parties and this compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences in betterment of their future life and in the light of ratio laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in this petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.28 dated 08.07.2011 registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar under Sections 406, 498-A, 420 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR are hereby quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
