This order shall dispose of LPA Nos.859, 860, 861, 862,
863, 864 of 1990 and 526 of 1995. All these LPAs have been filed by
the land-owners against the judgment dated 14.9.1988 passed by the

learned Single Judge, whereby the Regular First Appeal filed by the appellants was partly allowed in the following terms:

"For the foregoing reasons, the compensation of the acquired land is enhanced to Rs.950/- per acre by accepting this appeal as well as the other appeals filed by the land owners but rejecting the appeals filed by the State of Haryana. The appellants shall also be entitled to 30% solatium over and above the said compensation in view of the amended provisions of the Act. They shall also be entitled to an amount equal to 12% per annum over and above the market value from the date of publication of notification under Section 4 of the Act to the date of the award of the Collector or the date of taking possession of the land, whichever is earlier, under Section 23(1-A) of the Act. Besides this, they shall also be entitled to 9% per annum interest on the compensation of the acquired land for the first year of taking possession of the land and 15 % per annum onwards till its payment. The appellants shall also be entitled to proportionate costs of these appeals. If need be, the appellants shall make good the deficiency in the Court fee within a period of two months from today. The security or indemnity bonds furnished by different claimants while getting their compensation from the trial Court as per orders of this Court are ordered to be discharged."

Against the aforesaid judgment some LPAs were filed by the land-owners. In all those appeals the State has also filed cross-objections. All those appeals as well as cross-objections were dismissed by the Division Bench of this Court vide judgment dated

9.2.1998. Against the said decision the land-owners went in appeal i.e. Civil Appeal Nos.7812-7817 of 2002. All those appeals were subsequently dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the issue raised in these appeals are squarely covered by the decision of this Court in LPA No.1181 of 1988, which has been dismissed by this Court vide order dated 9.2.1998, these appeals are also hereby dismissed.
