JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 111, dated 28.08.2011, under Sections 452, 326, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have entered into compromise without any pressure, coercion and same has been done with the free consent of the parties. No other case is pending

between the parties. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 111, dated 28.08.2011, under Sections 452, 326, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Batala, District Gurdaspur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioner.
