Report of District and Sessions Judge, Moga, received vide which it has been reported that Gram Nayayalya has been established at Kot Ise Khan and is being presiding over by Civil Judge (Jr. Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga. He has also reported that some of the Advocates engaged by the parties are appearing while some others are not appearing before the Gram Nayayalya. According to the report 14 Advocates are appearing in Civil Cases and 3 are appearing in Criminal Cases. As per report, 17 Advocates are appearing and 43 Advocates are not appearing. 60 cases are pending in the said Court out of which 17 are of criminal nature and 43 are of Civil nature. Learned District and Sessions Judge, Moga also mentioned the names of the Advocates who are putting in appearance before Gram Nayayalya.

It being so the petitioner is always at liberty to engage a counsel who is ready to appear.

No ground is made out to transfer the case.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
