The petitioner prays for protection of his life and liberty
on the apprehension of threat to both.

On due consideration, I am of the view that no
interference is warranted. If the property of the petitioner is
threatened, he is at liberty to file a civil suit to protect the same
and in case he is being threatened resulting in violation of any
penal law, he would have a remedy of approaching the court of
Magistrate including filing of a complaint under Section 156(3)
Cr.P.C.
