JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Rajiv Kumar in case FIR No.114 dated 13.04.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

It is contended that petitioner was only an employee and the entire sale transactions were at the behest of the main accused Jasbir Singh, who is the principal coloniser. It is further contended that the said Jasbir Singh has paid up the complainant and has effected an amicable settlement apart from submitting that he has joined investigations.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh Singh submits that main accused Jasbir Singh has since been granted

anticipatory bail and further that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 06th of April, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
