Petitioner seeks regular bail under in FIR No.113 dated 23.11.2013 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

The FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ajwinder Singh, who was co-occupant of the car at the time of alleged occurrence. When the car was stopped near a chemist shop and he was about to alight the car for getting medicine, a white swift car arrived parallel to the car and the persons sitting in swift car opened fire, smashing glass windowpanes of the car of

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complainant, besides injuring Gurmeet Singh, who was on the driver seat.

Learned counsel stated that the petitioner was not named in the FIR. The petitioner made supplementary statement, alleging that petitioner was also co-occupant of swift car and on the instigation of Dilpreet Singh and others, Sukhpreet Singh opened fire.

Learned counsel relied upon CRM-M No.140 of 2014 and CRM-M No.16541 of 2014, whereby Dilpreet Singh was granted concession of anticipatory bail and Mohd. Shakeel and Jagtar Singh were granted benefit of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the case of the petitioner is at par with other co-accused, who have been granted bail by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions From ASI Deepak Sharma, however, opposed the bail application.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
