This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.109 dated 16.11.2014, registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner Gurcharan Singh and Sandeep Kaur got married against the wishes of their parents. At present they are living together.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sangrur. Same is taken on record. According to her, investigation of the matter is still pending. She further submits that factum of marriage of the petitioners and other circumstances shall be taken into consideration by the investigating officer before submitting final report under section 173 Cr.P.C.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction from this court is necessary. Petition is disposed of. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to file afresh in case any cause of action survives after filing of the final report by the investigating agency.
