SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The prayer in this petition is for seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.116 dated 5.08.2014 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341, 427, 506, 452, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 23.01.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation on 30.01.2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, who is present in Court submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and an iron sickle has already been recovered from him.

In view of the above, the interim concession of anticipatory bail given to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions enshrined in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.. The petitioner will appear before the learned trial Court within 30 days from today and will move an application for being enlarged on regular bail.
